## On-Boarding Instructions for Android and iOS platforms

In conjunction with our technical partner- Client Outlook- the ENITS program team is pleased to announce ENITS is now available for **iOS (Apple)** and **Android (Google)** mobile devices. Both platforms are available from the respective on-line store.

The balance of this document provides instructions on the process to access the images in ENITS test.

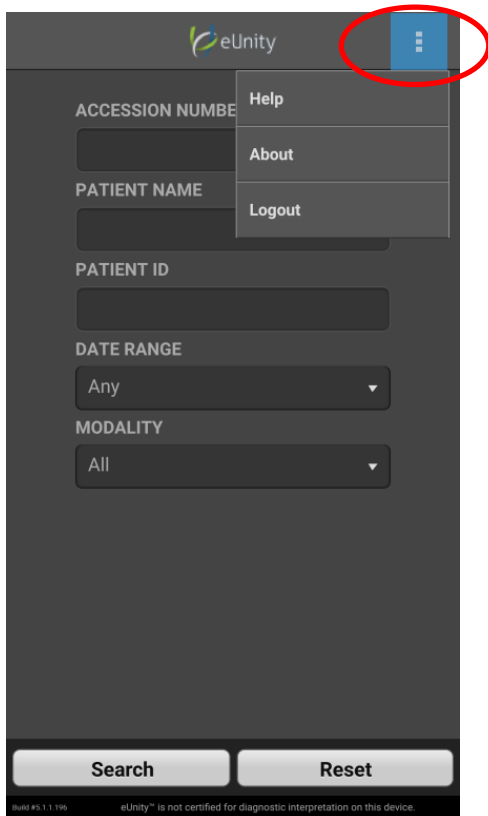
### **1. Logging into ENITS Mobile**

Your **existing ENITS username and existing password** must be used to access either ENITS mobile application. You are still required to answer **one (1)** challenge question.

### **2. Instructions to access the respective application** are presented in the following order:

1. Android
2. Apple

### **3. Help Files and Mobile features-** files are located inside the application under the Help tab (top right hand corner of the main screen). These files will open in a new browser window.

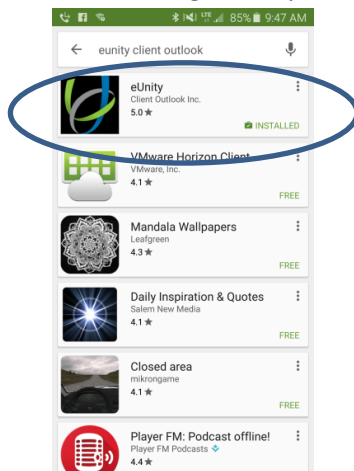

### 1. Loading eUnity on an Android device

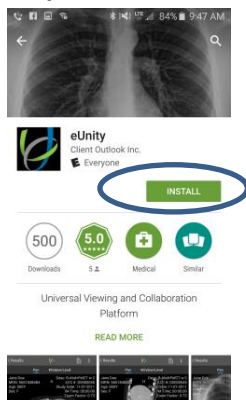
These instructions are specific to the eUnity application available from the Google Play Store.

Search using “eUnity Client Outlook” to refine the result



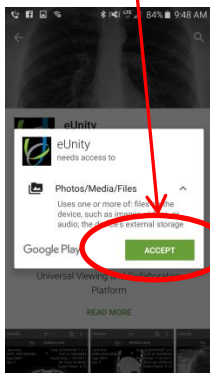
#### **Step 2: Select the eUnity application and install**



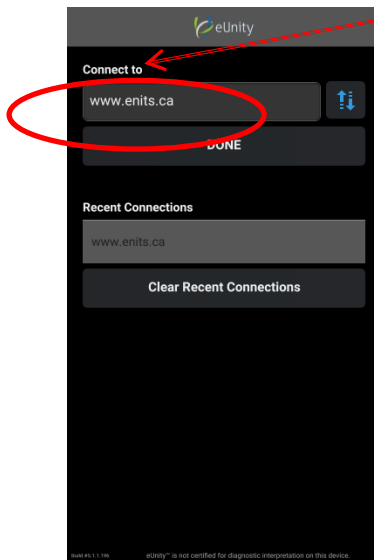

**Step 3:** Accept eUnity's request to access photos/ media and files.

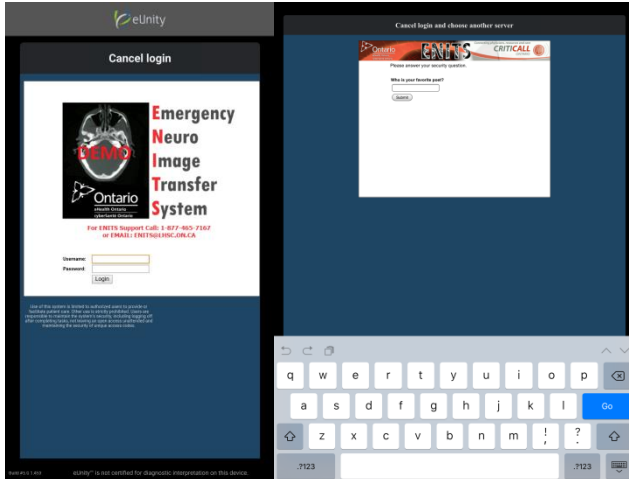


**Step 4:** Once the application is installed and opened, you will be prompted to [Connect to](#) one of the domains. In this field enter: [www.enits.ca](http://www.enits.ca)

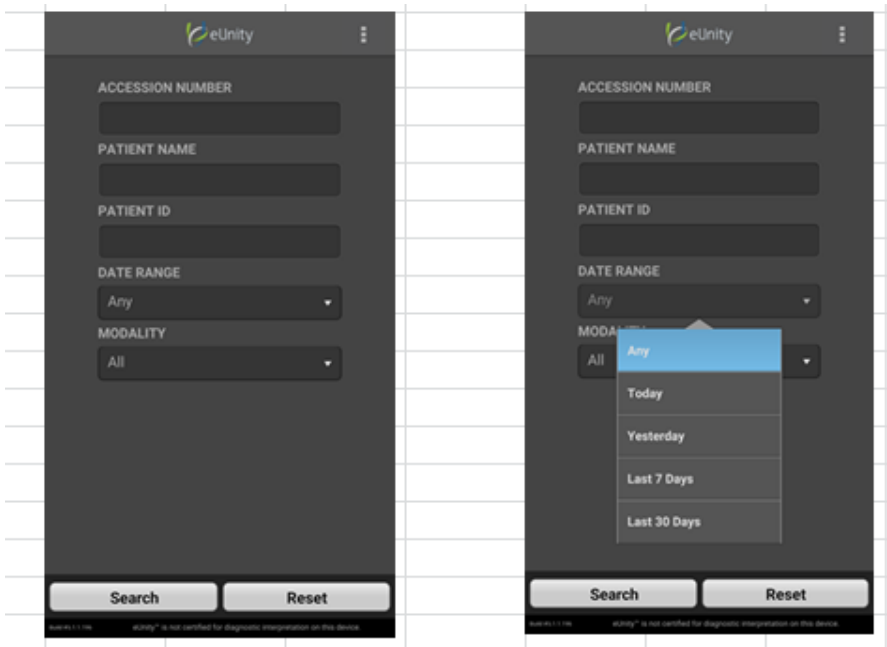


**Step 5:** Once inside the application, you will be required to authenticate using your [existing](#) ENITS account credentials.

**Step 6:** The search screen is exactly the same as exists via your desktop/ lap top. Fuzzy name searches are possible. Date range searches are unchanged.

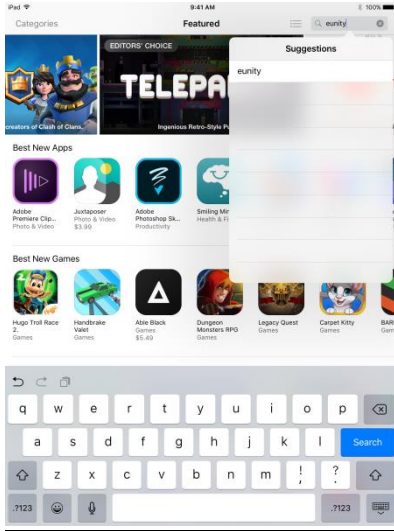


## **2. Loading eUnity on an Apple device**

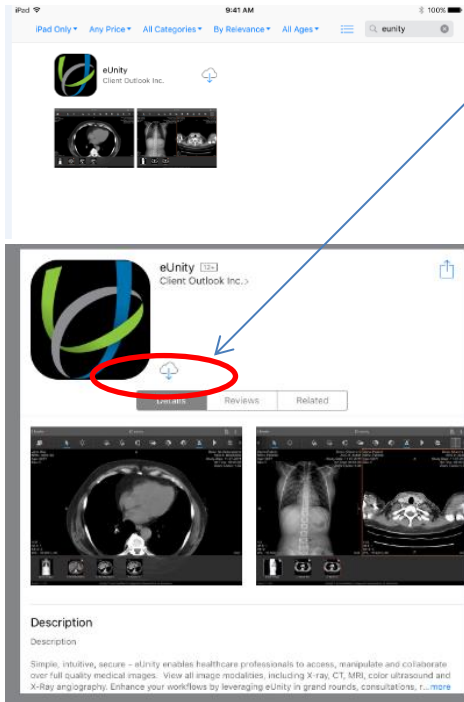
