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TRAINING

The SWODIN Project Team, in collaboration with Agfa’s Customer Training Team and the Regional Project Leads, have prepared organizational training activities aimed at providing the information and instruction required to help the PACS end-user attain the required level of knowledge and skill to a specified standard.

Training activities are often most successful when offered through ‘just in time’ delivery. Standardized plans, tools, resources and media have been put in place to meet the initial needs prior to and during implementation. Training commences on May 28th and runs through to Go-Live with the planning and scheduling of the training method coordinated by site Project Leads.

RADIOLOGIST TRAINING

We believe that the best approach for Radiologists is 1:1 hands on training. Prescheduled training sessions have been coordinated with the assistance of regional project leads. The training will be provided by Agfa Clinical Applications Specialists.

DIAGNOSTIC/MEDICAL IMAGING TECHNOLOGISTS

The training of Technologists is a site coordinated activity and will be delivered by site System Administrators and System Super Users.

PHYSICIANS/CLINICIANS/SPECIALISTS

When accessing PACS via the EMR, the end-user will be see no change in how the image will launch and will now

be presented with the image in the Agfa Xero Viewer which has replaced the Centricity Web. For those that currently access Centricity Web via other access points, these will be replaced by Agfa Xero Viewer. Users of the Agfa Xero Viewer will be prompted to observe a short training/orientation video on first log in.

For those groups that require 1:1 training, educational videos and/or documentation, the SWODIN project team has worked with Regional Project Leads to help identify those end-users and to assist with the provision of training resources. An example of this would be the Emergency Physicians who require training on the PACS Discrepancy Workflow. The coordination and planning of these training sessions is a site activity and will be delivered by site System Administrators and/or System Users. You are advised to contact your site Project Lead (identified on Page 1 of this document) if you are not yet aware of your training methodology.

ORTHOPAEDIC MediCAD SOFTWARE

The integration with OrthoView for orthopaedic templating is being replaced with MediCAD. The SWODIN project team has contacted all regional sites that currently utilize OrthoView for templating to coordinate training on MediCAD in early June.
